


## The puzzle method, each student knows a little part

- The students are divided into groups
- The material (text, film or picture) is divided into
- parts
- Each student in the original group gets one part to study
- The students meet in mixed groups to discuss what's important in the part they are studying. They prepare to tell their original group
- The students meet in the original group and tell each other about their part
- All students make sure that they have understood the whole material
- The original groups get some more difficult questions or problems to solve
- The solutions are presented to the class

Step 1: Groups where the students study one part each of the material



Step 2: Students meet in mixed groups and discuss with others that have studied the same part



Step 3: Presentation in original groups. Problem solving
