Cross-group work

- Place the students in groups of 4-5 students
- Let them draw a picture or symbols to represent their discussion of a common question
- Let one student in each group remain at the table while the others devide themselves between the other tables in the classroom
- The remaining student get audience from the other groups and should explain and tell them what the drawing represents
- When they are ready the whole groupe move to the next table
- The student that has been involved in drawing what is on the table tells what the drawing represents
- The groups move on from one table to the next until they have visited all tables and all students have been allowed to present
- Finally, you gather in the original group and discuss what you have heard during your visit to the other groups
